Make a referral to a HUB Navigator to connect someone to a chronic disease prevention and management program that best supports their health.



After someone joins a health program, HUB Navigators identify any food needs and can help them get started with the HUB Fresh Produce Program.

The HUB Produce Box Program bridges the gap between nutrition education and access to healthy food, helping individuals learn healthy eating habits from trusted community-based organizations in their own neighborhoods and put those habits into practice at home with fresh produce delivered to the doorsteps of Iowans with the greatest need.
