Eligibility & requirements

- Be at least 18 years of age at the commencement of service
- Be a citizen, national, or lawful permanent resident alien of the United States
- Fulfill a hybrid or in-person service arrangement at the Host Site
- Satisfy the National Service Criminal History Check eligibility criteria
- Complete 1200 service hours within a one year timeframe (~23 hrs / week)

Benefits for Service Members

Living Allowance

\$7,144, paid out biweekly over the course of service



Segal Education Award & Student Loan Forbearance

\$5,176 upon successful completion of service

Gain professional experience working in the public health field



Public Health Network

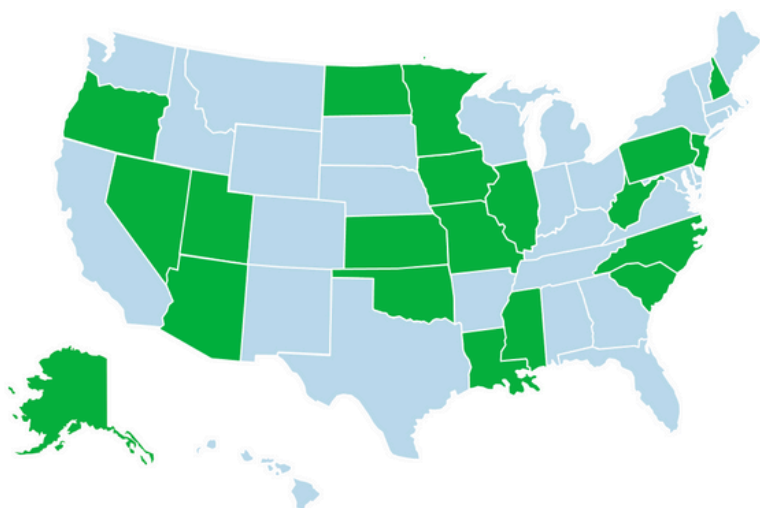
