

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, it is estimated that 17.7 percent of Iowa citizens are 65 years of age or older; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that one fourth of people 65 and older will fall each year; and

WHEREAS, falls are the leading cause of unintentional injury deaths in Iowa and the number of falls in Iowa is higher than the national average; and

WHEREAS, the financial toll for older adult falls is expected to increase as the population ages and may reach \$101 billion nationally by 2030; and

WHEREAS, the estimated average charges for fall-related hospitalizations are increasing and account for more than \$415 million annually; and

WHEREAS, falls among older adults occur in all socioeconomic and cultural groups; and

WHEREAS, injuries from falls are primarily a preventable community health problem; and

WHEREAS, members of the Iowa Falls Prevention Coalition are working to increase awareness of this issue, promote multidisciplinary strategies to prevent falls and encourage citizens to take steps to protect those who are at increased risk of falling; and

WHEREAS, guided by a community-level collaboration of researchers, healthcare providers, and community stakeholders, Iowa is working to increase statewide fall risk screening and the dissemination of evidence-based programs in efficient and equitable ways.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Kim Reynolds, Governor of the State of Iowa, do hereby proclaim September 18-22, 2023, as:
