



STEADI Fall Risk Screening Course

The course provides foundational training on the STEADI fall risk screening protocol developed by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) as well as information on evidence-based interventions and how to effectively refer individuals to these programs through the Iowa Community HUB.

The training course was developed in collaboration with the Iowa Falls Prevention Coalition, which seeks to expand the use of coordinated fall risk screening across the state. The course is appropriate for a range of professionals (both clinicians and nonclinicians) since screening can be conducted with different levels of sophistication.

The fully online course is coordinated and managed by a research team from ISU Translation Research Network (U-TuRN) with expertise in fall-prevention screening and programming. Contact our team for questions or information about supplemental 'liveintensive' training.
